## **The Role**

This is both a clean room and laboratory-based position involving the receipt of goods, packaging a manufactured predefined specification, record keeping in line with the manufacturing process and undergoing our incoming quality control procedure. This role will include supporting our precision dispensing technician as they undergo the manufacturing process using our ultra-low volume dispensing systems. It will also include the operating and maintaining laboratory equipment (including centrifuges, autoclave, laminar flow etc) and general laboratory upkeep and maintenance.

This position is currently carried out 24/6 and therefore candidates will be expected to work on a shift rotation at 40 hours a week.
